



What are the Team Captain's responsibilities?

BEFORE WHEEL-A-THON DAY

- 1) Form a team and choose a team name.
- 2) Complete team roster and register members with the CDR Wheel-A-Thon officials.
- 3) Collect money raised by the team & turn it in with Pledge Sheets to Wheel-A-Thon officials, (Please try to do this on a rolling basis so we can keep track of the leading fundraisers).
- 4) Keep up team moral and encourage fund raising.
- 5) Attend the Wheel-A-Thon Kick Off party (this is optional for other team members).

DAY OF THE WHEEL-A-THON

- 1) Sign in at registration table.
- 2) Organize your team & stick together.
- 3) Make sure each team member is registered and has signed the waiver forms.
- 4) Turn in additional money raised to Wheel-A-Thon officials.
- 5) Pick up the wheelchair assigned to your team at the Wheelchair Booth.
- 6) Return wheelchair after completing the Wheel-A-Thon.
- 7) Attend picnic and awards presentation.
